

“Do Good. God Sees.”

Gal. 6:9-10

I have a confession to make. Sometimes I get a little weary trying to keep up with my hectic schedule and all the demands of my life. Now, I'm the first to admit: some of this is just my fault. Not everything I've said “yes” to is necessarily exactly what God wants me to do. It's a privilege to share, but when I'm tempted to complain, God reminds me of His goodness and indeed the privilege to share with others.

We are all expressions of the love of God to others. Let's face it. The only Jesus some will see is the Jesus in your life. Doing what is right and good toward others is really at the core of this thing called Christianity.

That's why we're instructed in Galatians chapter 6, verses 9 and 10, that we should always be motivated to do what is right. Listen to these rallying words; “And let us not lose heart in doing good. For in due season we shall reap if we do not grow weary. So then while we have opportunity, let us do good to all men and especially to those who are of the household of faith.”

Paul's basically saying, “Don't quit doing good. Don't give up doing good.” You may be discouraged right now. Maybe you don't think anybody knows, recognizes, or appreciates what you're doing. You could be right. That may not be distorted thinking. Maybe you're sharing with people and your good works are being misinterpreted, cast aside, or not appreciated. Don't believe the lie, though, that it's going unnoticed. God sees. It's always right to do what is good and what is right. He will reward you.

Here's what I want you to remember today. It's always right to do right and it's always good to do good. Don't get discouraged. God sees everything that you're doing.
