I love the prayer in Ephesians chapter 3, verses 16 through 19. Listen to these words; “That He would grant you, according to the riches of His glory, to be strengthened with power through His Spirit in the inner man, so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith, and that you, being rooted and grounded in love, may be able to comprehend with all the saints what is the breadth and length and height and depth, and to know the love of Christ which surpasses knowledge that you may be filled up to all the fullness of God.”

“That you may be filled up with all the fullness of God.” Paul prays and says, “I want you to understand the enormous resources our Heavenly Father has. He's never run out. He doesn't have any limitations. He has everything we need.”

God wants to flood your life right now with His divine resources. He wants to give you what you need to overcome the challenges before you. Don't be intimidated by your circumstances. Don't think that you're lacking. Don't wring your hands. God has everything you need, and He is there for you.

Here's what I want you to remember today. If you're overwhelmed by your circumstances, pause and make Ephesians chapter 3, verses 16 through 19, your prayer. God will give you everything you need to get through.
