On a ministry trip to South Africa some years ago, my wife, Karen, and I toured the capital city of Pretoria. Acts chapter 23, verse 12 says; “When it was day, the Jews made a plot and bound themselves by an oath neither to eat nor drink till they had killed Paul.” Then Acts chapter 23, verse 16 says; “Now the son of Paul's sister heard of their ambush, so he went and entered the barracks and told Paul.”

So here's what I want you to remember today. If you're a candidate for deliverance, keep your ears open to God. Listen for His course of action. Then do exactly what He says.
