

Hi, I'm Crawford Loritts with a Legacy Moment. God has given us more than we need for the journey.

About a decade ago, my Aunt Rebecca went home to be with the Lord. She was legendary for her generous spirit. Literally minutes before she passed away, she sent my cousins on an errand to the store. It was a little weird. She gave them what amounted to be way more money than they needed. My cousins protested, but she insisted, "I want you to have all this money. Just get what you need and share the rest of it among you." As soon as they left the house, she collapsed on the kitchen floor and died. Aunt Rebecca hated seeing anyone in need. In a strange way, she died the way she lived.

In much the same way, God has not left us in need, has He? In fact, He made us wealthy, when you think about it. The death of Christ released God's resources to us. Paul was so excited about this that he wrote a letter to the Church at Corinth, underscoring this point. He says in First Corinthians chapter 1, verses 4 through 7, "I give thanks to my God always for you because of the grace of God that was given you in Christ Jesus, that in every way you were enriched..." Did you catch that? "...in every way you were enriched in him in all speech and all knowledge—even as the testimony about Christ was confirmed among you—so that you are not lacking in any spiritual gift..." Paul says, in essence, "God has made you wealthy. You have more than you need. You've been enriched."

Here's what I want you to remember today. Perhaps you're feeling empty and at a loss. God wants you to know you're not lacking in anything. You have Christ, and with Him comes everything. You have more than enough.
