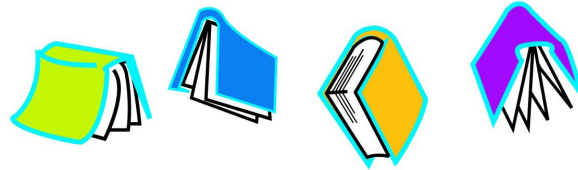


# Midday Book Club
