XDS Program Identification (PID) Changes | Deadline - Friday, Sept. 5

Moody Radio program affiliates using the XDS receiver platform for programming from Moody-1 and Moody-2 face a Sept. 5 deadline for updating their Program Identifications or PIDs.

Why is this happening?

These changes stem from the spring migration of our satellite feed from SES-2 to SES-11, which was completed June 1. Now, the PID numbers for all programs aired on Moody-1 and Moody-2 will be changing over the period from Monday, August 11 through Friday, September 5.

What are the new PIDS?

The old Moody-1 PID, 1200 will be changing to PID 1205. The old Moody-2 PID of 06D2 will be changing to PID 1206.

What has happened so far? Moody Radio 24/7/365 Partners

On Thursday, August 7, Moody Global Media/Moody Radio operations changed XDS receivers scheduled with 24/7/365 coverage of Moody-1 and/or Moody-2, via the XDS Network Management System to the new PIDs. That means about 75% of the XDS receivers across the network are now up to date.

How can I verify if my XDS receiver is set to the new PIDs?

Affiliates can check if their receivers are set to Moody-1 (MB1 Live) or Moody-2 (MB2 Live) in a couple of ways:

How does our station/network do this?

- On the front panel of the receiver navigate to Audio Ports and select MOODY 1
 NEW or MOODY 2 NEW
- On the receiver's user interface website by using the command:

- o PORT PID A 1205 (for MB1) and/or
- o **PORT PID B 1206** (for MB2)

What if my station or network rides the Moody-1 or Moody- 2 feed but also schedules some of our own content from Moody?

Stations utilizing this **hybrid model** for the XDS affiliate website specifically to:

- schedule selected programs only along with silence between selected programs
- who use the site for scheduled program time-shifting
- or a combination of Moody-1 (MB1) live as well as time-shifted programs

Hybrid partners will need to reload all customized programs using the new PIDs for Moody-1 and/or Moody-2.

This process for hybrid stations/networks has been underway since August 12 and needs to be wrapped up by the deadline of Friday, September 5.

If I am a hybrid station/network can we do this ourselves?

Yes, please find the link to the tech specs with detailed instructions for affiliate personnel to be able to update their XDS programming schedules on their own.

You Will Need These Items to Update the PIDs on Your XDS

- XDS Affiliate website Login and password
- Serial number for your machine
- Print out of your XDS Site programming schedule(s)
- A reference copy of your station's program schedule (optional)
