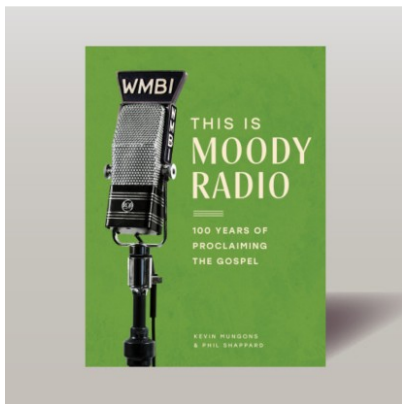

Moody-1 Programming Metadata Now Available

This new capability allows affiliates to extract program metadata—including song title, artist name, and duration—from the Moody-1 audio feed for use with most RBDS (Radio Broadcast Data Systems), HD Radio systems, and audio streaming platforms. Listeners can see this information on compatible radio displays, such as a vehicle's digital dashboard.

At the request of an affiliate with a unique operational need, Moody Radio's engineering team accelerated development of this solution by embedding Program Associated Data (PAD) into the audio-over-IP feed between the Chapman Center in Chicago and the Microspace Communications uplink site near Raleigh, North Carolina.

A new Tech Specs guide explains how the system works and demonstrates how affiliates can use the PAD port on the XDS receiver to extract Moody-1 metadata and integrate it into their local systems.

As additional affiliates implement this capability, Moody Radio plans to expand the guide with examples from a variety of equipment configurations.
