Burnt Leviticus 1:1-17	Cattle, Sheep Goats, Birds	Offerer -Lay on hand and kill animal Priest - Sprinkle blood on side of altar, put on fire. Entirely burned	Complete Consecration “Offer up in smoke all of it”	Present ourselves living sacrifices, wholly consecrated to God Romans 12:1
Grain Leviticus 2:1-16	Raw flour, cooked cakes, roasted new grain	Flour - labor oil - anointing incense - soothing aroma	Acceptable service to God	All our labor should be offered to God as acceptable service Col 3:17
Peace (Fellowship) Leviticus 3:1-17	Cattle, Sheep, Goats	Blood on sides of altar Fat portions burned meat shared by priests and offerers	Celebration Meal (Gratitude/Free Will)	We should celebrate the Lord’s Table 1 Cor 10:16-18
Sin Leviticus 4:1-5:13	Cattle, Sheep Goats, Birds	Substitution Identification Death Exchange of Life	Forgiveness by faith in a substitutionary sacrifice	We must receive forgiveness by faith in the Messiah’s substitutionary sacrifice 2 Cor 5:21
Guilt (Restitution) Leviticus 5:14-6:7	Rams	Blood around altar Fat Burned	Make restitution to God (5:15-16) or to fellow persons (6:4-5)	Be reconciled and make restitution for wrong done. Matt 5:23-24
