The Spirit of God was moving over the
surface of the waters

Gen 1:2

God saw everything and it was very good

Gen 2:1

God finished His work

Gen 2:2

So God blessed the seventh day

and sanctified it

Seven Acts/Marked by Divine Speech

“And the Lord said . . .”

Ex 25:1; 30:11, 17 22 34; 31:1, 12

I have filled him (Bezalel) with
the Spirit of God

Ex 31:3; 35:31

Moses saw all the work . . . so had they done it

Ex 35:43

All the work of the tabernacle was finished

Ex 39:32

Moses finished the work

Ex 40:33

And Moses blessed them

Ex 39:43

God commanded Israel to rest on the seventh
day and to sanctify it

Ex 31:12-18

The tabernacle had pure gold
and precious jewels

Ex 25:3; 18

The tabernacle had the Law
in the Holy of Holies

Exod 25:16; Deut 31:26; Prov 3:18

The Lord walked in the midst of the tent

Lev 26:12; Deut 23:14

Levites to “serve” (worship) and “heed”
(obey) in the tabernacle
