#### FTP Site Maintenance Outage | July 4–7



## **XDS-PROS Receivers Now Available**

With the recent satellite switch from SES-2 to SES-11 now completed, some affiliates have asked about new receiver options to replace their aging model XDS-PRO1Q and/or XDS-PRO4Q receivers originally deployed in 2012–2013.

Many of these receivers are now 13+ years old, and factory repair support for these models ended in 2020. While the new SES-11 satellite feed can still be accessed by

the older "Q" model receivers, this may be a good time to consider upgrading to the current "S" model of XDS receivers.

The **XDS-PRO1S** (one audio output) and the **XDS-PRO4S** (four audio outputs) digital media receivers include a 256 GB solid state storage drive, an AES Livewire+ port, as well as the familiar DB-9 analog audio output(s), LAN-1, LAN-2 ethernet ports, and DB-37 relay ports. See the tech spec links for each model above.

Most affiliates can proceed with a new XDS-PRO1S single audio output receiver and still have access to both Moody-1 and Moody-2 by using the **XDS Affiliate website** for programming and scheduling via the XDS Network Management System.

Moody Radio has several XDS-PRO1S and XDS-PRO4S receivers for sale:

- XDS-PRO1S (one audio output), with 245 GB SSD \$2,255.00
- XDS-PRO4S (four audio outputs). With 256 GB SSD \$2,950.00
